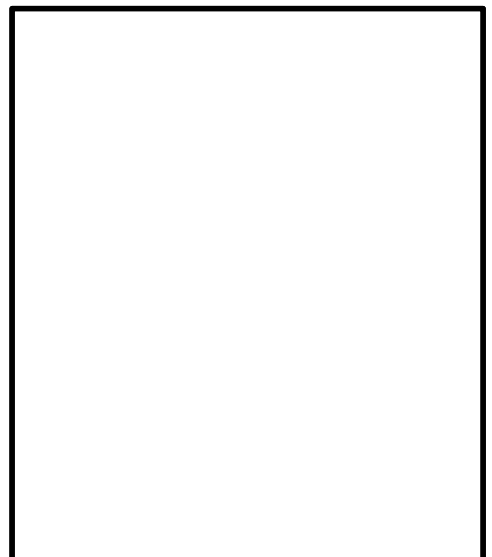
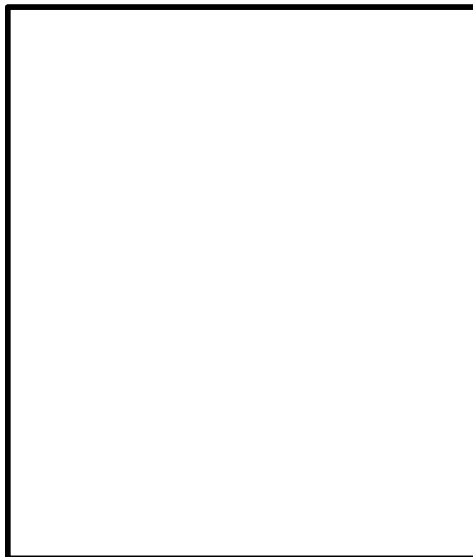
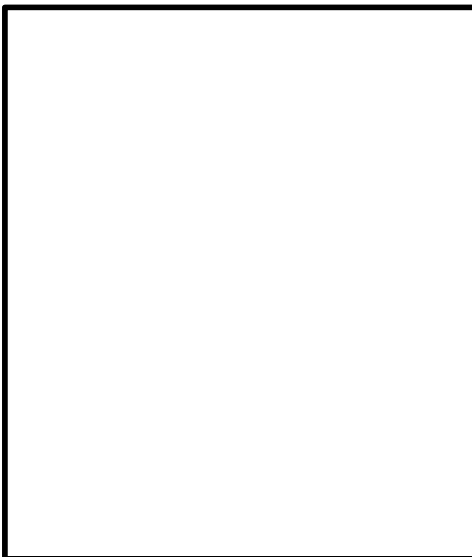
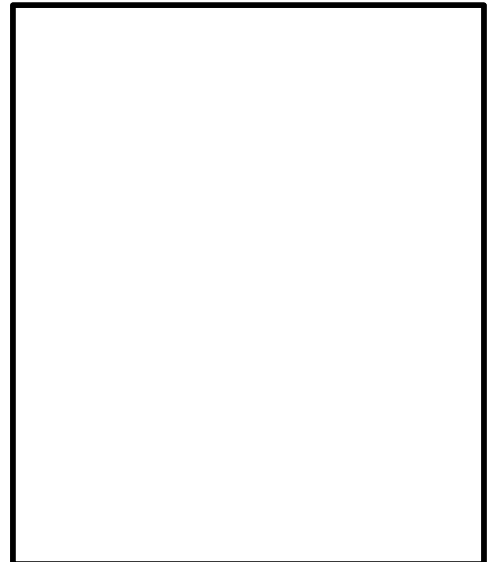
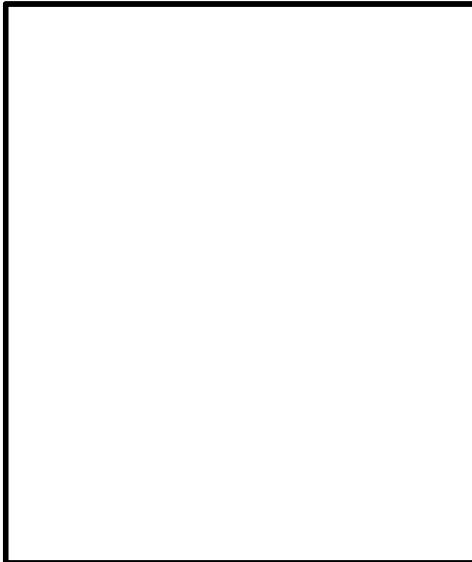
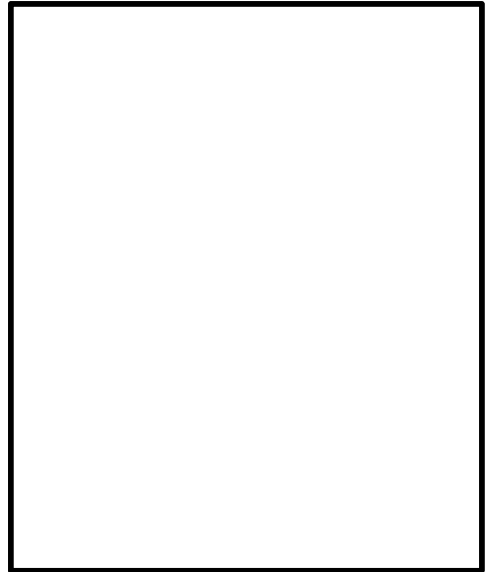
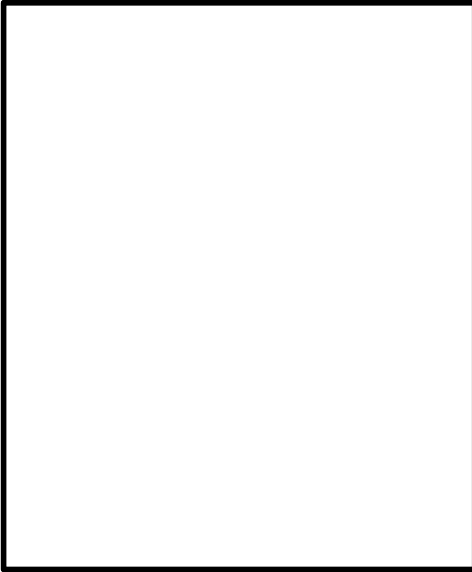


Page 1: The Baltimore Disaster [Voice & thoughts of hero & characters + Narrator]

- The disaster ends, leaving much of Baltimore destroyed.

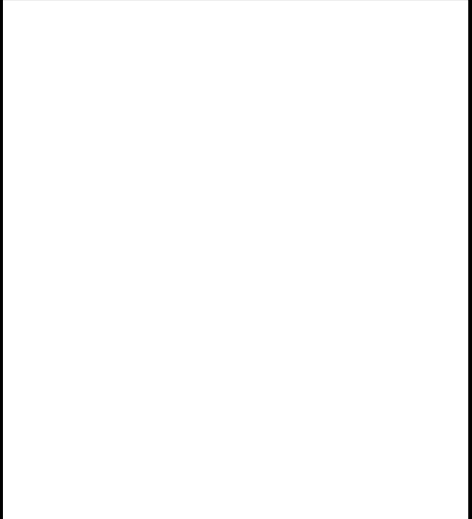
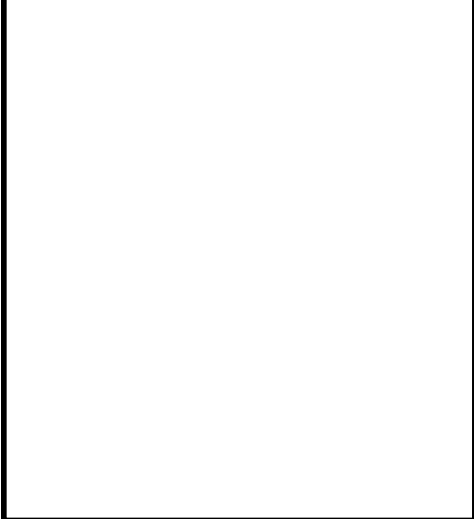
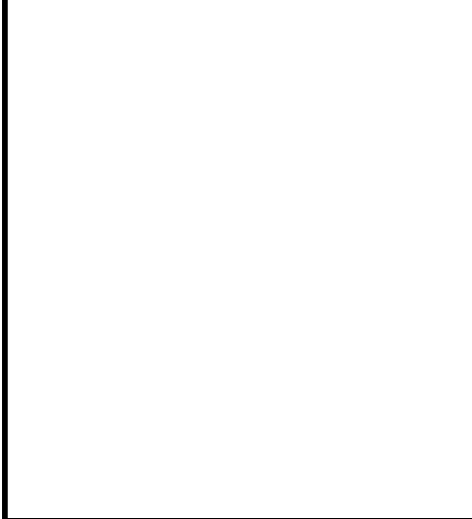
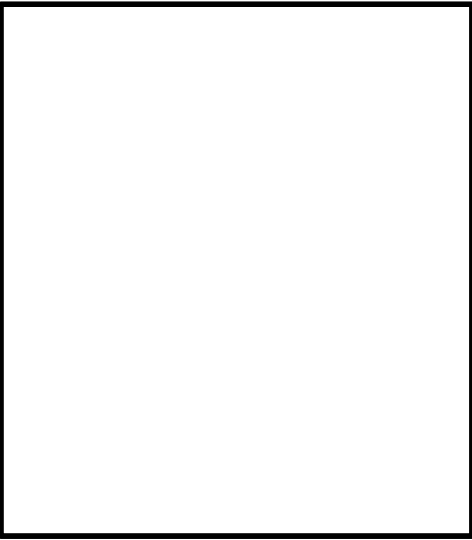
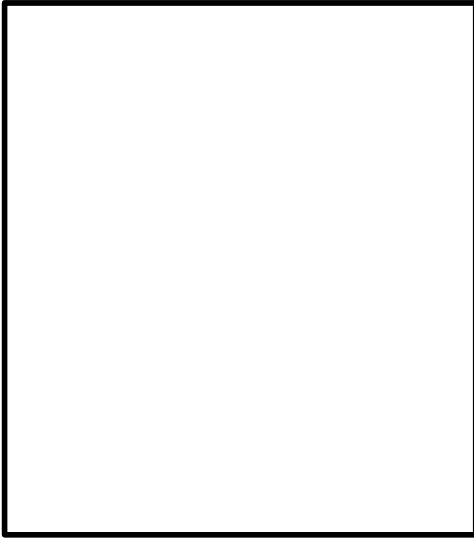
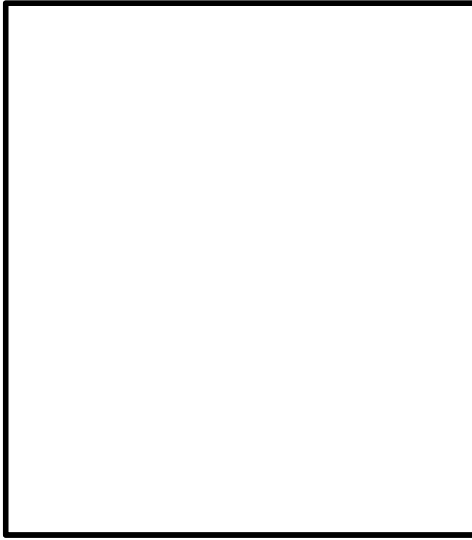
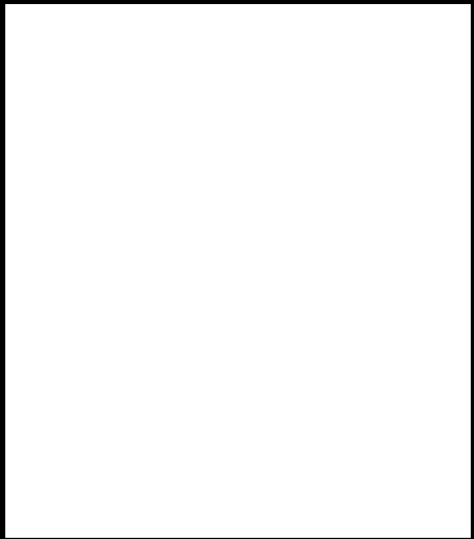
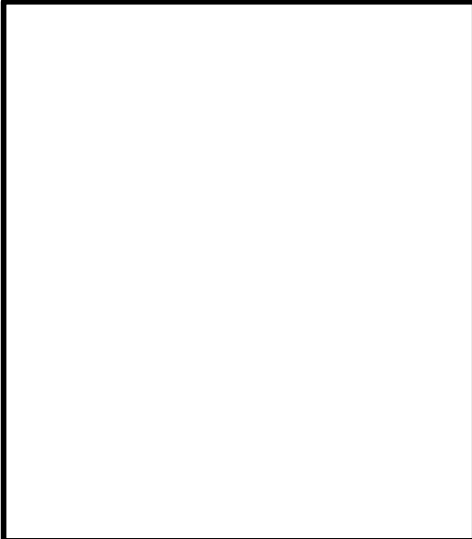


Page 2: The Aftermath and Metamorphosis [Voice & thoughts of hero & characters + Narrator]

- Baltimore damage briefly explained, but shown throughout page 2 (background images)
- Include one or more iconic Baltimore buildings to establish that the setting is Baltimore.
- Hero changes to superhero. Show & Explain:
 - What is the **cause** of the change?
 - What specifically are the hero's new **superpowers**?
- Hero declares that he/she will fix Baltimore, making it better than ever.

Page 3: Organizing, Rebuilding & Improving Baltimore Voice & thoughts of hero & characters

- Hero **organizes** and **leads** the survivors in the **planning** and **rebuilding** of Baltimore.
- Hero travels throughout Baltimore, fixing and **improving Baltimore** (Example: crime, pollution, public transit, schools, housing, homelessness, unemployment, etc.)



Page 4: The New & Improved Baltimore Voice of Narrator + Hero

1. (Narrator) Explain & show the new and improved Baltimore.
2. (Narrator) Explain & show why the citizens of the new Baltimore will be happier living in the new Baltimore.
3. (Hero) Conclusion statement: "Baltimore is _____."
